Wynnie Wu-Cosgrove, originally from Hong Kong, is a champion record holder in long distance and 24-hour marathons. She started racing in 1992 at the Annual Hong Kong Golden Mile Road Race, and in 1995, her team won the Hong Kong Trailwalker Race, finishing with a time of 14 hours, 26 minutes. She moved to New Zealand with her husband in 1994. Wynnie has represented New Zealand in the 100km, 12-hour and 24-hour marathons in Japan, Taiwan, France, The Netherlands, and Italy from 1994-2003 and is currently the national champion and record holder for all three races. Wynnie has won a number of national and international sports awards, including the New Zealand Hillary Commission Winning Women Role Model, the Sri Chinmoy Medal for Services to Sport, and the IAAF medal for services to Women's Sport. She currently works as newspaper columnist, free-lance writer, sports coach, chef, and a proud mother.
